Biography

Dr Andreas Glindemann is Head of the Instrument Systems Group at the European Southern Observatory, and Lecturer (Privat-Dozent) at the Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität Munich.

He was elected into the ESO Staff Committee for the first time in 2002, and has spent since then a total of nine years on the Staff Committee.

Dr Glindemann joined ESO in 1997, leading and coordinating the development of the VLT Interferometer, its subsystems and instruments, as Head of the VLTI Group until 2006. He was then appointed Adaptive Optics Facility Scientist before taking over the Instrument Systems Group in 2011 with responsibility for instruments both for the VLT and for the Extremely Large Telescope.

Dr Glindemann graduated in Physics at the Technical University in Braunschweig (Germany) in 1983. He received his PhD in 1989 from the Technical University in Berlin and his habilitation in Physics in 1998 from the University Heidelberg.
