Biography

Matthew Eyton-Jones is Chief Executive Officer of the Pension Fund of CERN, the European Organization for Nuclear Research, based in Geneva, Switzerland.

Matthew joined CERN on 1st July 2015 as CEO of the CERN Pension Fund. He has 20 years' experience of managing institutional pension funds and has worked for a number of international organisations including the John Lewis Partnership, Goldman Sachs, Bank of America and Mercer Consulting.

Matthew is a graduate of both the Advanced Leadership Programme and General Management Programme at Judge Business School, University of Cambridge and of the Investment Management Programme at London Business School. He is a member of the Chartered Institute for Securities & Investment and the Chartered Insurance Institute by examination.

He has a wider interest in the governance and investment management of charities, foundations, endowments, sovereign wealth funds, and family offices.

Matthew is elected to the Alumni Advisory Council at Judge Business School, University of Cambridge, is a Life Fellow of the Royal Society of Arts, a Fellow of the Royal Geographical Society, a Member of Chatham House, and a Freeman of the City of London.

He has previously served as an expert at the World Economic Forum advising on retirement investment systems, a board member at Villiers Park Educational Trust, a member of the Integrity Committee at the Chartered Institute for Securities & Investment, and spent several years serving in the Royal Navy Reserve.
