Biography

Véronique Halloin graduated in civil chemical engineering in 1986 and obtained a PhD in applied sciences in 1992.

She became full professor at Université Libre de Bruxelles in 2000, at the head of the chemical engineering research group, and hold the position of vice-head and head of the bioengineering school from 2000 to 2006, and vice-rector in charge of research and development, from 2006 to 2008.

Since October 2008, she is Secretary General of the F.R.S.-FNRS. Flagship in the French speaking Belgium, the FNRS supports researchers in basic research in all scientific fields. The FNRS is in particular the employer of 2300 researchers at different levels of their career.

She is member of several boards and organizations, such as Science Europe, Academia Belgica, Welbio, the Queen Elisabeth Medical Foundation, the Fulbright Commission Belgium, The Federal Council of Science Policy. She also acts as Belgian delegate at the CERN Finance Committee and General Council, and at the Global Science Forum (OCDE).
