Biography

Marcus Klug graduated from the University of Economics and Business in Vienna with a masters degree in business administration with a focus on finance and financial markets as well as public economy.

He started his professional career at Reuters and joined Creditanstalt Investment Bank in Vienna and Warsaw in 1995 initially as an equities analyst and later moved to the corporate finance area.

In 1997, Marcus moved to London to work at Barclays Capital in the derivatives area. After a move to Dresdner Kleinwort he returned to Vienna at the end of 1999 and started at UNIQA Finanz-Service GmbH as senior portfolio manager for UNIQA's investment portfolio.

From 2002 until 2005, he ran UNIQA Alternative Investments as managing director. At the end of 2005, he co-founded Omicron Investment Management and 2006 Lionheart Risk Solutions and remained a member of the management boards until 2008.

From 2003 to 2013, Marcus was a lecturer at the Institute of Banking and Finance at the University of Economics and Business in Vienna. On 1 October 2008 Mr. Klug was appointed to the executive board of directors of Bundespensionskasse AG, the public pension fund for civil servants government employees, and has since been responsible for investments and finance at Bundespensionskasse AG.
